**SEPTEMBER 1:
WELCOME**

- Private coach pickup at Barcelona Airport for transfer to Perpignan.
- 7-night stay at the 4-star Mercure Perpignan Centre with a welcome drink.
- Hotel offers views of the Castillet and is near attractions like Saint-Jean-Baptiste Cathedral and Hyacinthe Rigaud Museum, with the Palace of the Kings of Majorca a 15-minute walk away.
- Perpignan features a rich blend of cultural, culinary, and sporting experiences in the Pyrénées-Orientales region.



**SEPTEMBER 2:
DOMAINE LAFAGE
AND VISA FESTIVAL**

- Start with a hearty breakfast before visiting Domaine Lafage winery in Roussillon with a private guide.
- Tour the vineyards, learn about regenerative viticulture, and enjoy wine tastings with local delicacies.
- Return to Perpignan for an apéritif on Rue Paratilla, soaking in the atmosphere with a light snack.
- In the afternoon, take a guided tour of the VISA pour l'Image exhibitions by an accredited expert.
- At 5:00 PM, meet Mayor Louis Aliot at City Hall for an informal chat and a traditional Catalan snack. Enjoy your evening at leisure before returning to your hotel.



**SEPTEMBER 3:
PERPIGNAN**

- Kick off your day with a hearty breakfast.
- Set off with a private guide to discover the beauty of Perpignan. Enjoy the allure of its Mediterranean streets aboard a charming little train. As the former capital of the Kings of Majorca, Perpignan is home to 32 Historic Monuments, 5 museums, and is celebrated as a "City of Arts and History."
- Take part in a guided tour of the Art Nouveau Hôtel Pams, savor a typical Catalan lunch at La Casa Sansa, and explore the Rigaud Museum to admire its art collections.
- Wrap up your day with coffee at the Galeries Lafayette terrace, where you can enjoy breathtaking views of the Castillet, along with some time for shopping.



**SEPTEMBER 4:
CÔTE VERMEILLE**

- Enjoy breakfast before departing by coach for Côte Vermeille along the scenic coastal road. Arrive in Collioure for an unforgettable adventure! Experience a ride on the Little Train, winding through vineyards and along charming paths.
- Make a brief stop at Fort Saint-Elme to take in the stunning views. Then, descend to Port-Vendres via the quays, returning to Collioure along the Corniche.
- Savor a Winemaker's Picnic Lunch at Domaine Tambour in Banyuls-sur-Mer, complete with a cellar tour and wine tasting.
- Following lunch, partake in a guided tour of Collioure and the Château Royal, with some free time for local shopping.
- Conclude the day with a return to the hotel for an overnight stay.



**SEPTEMBER 5:
CARCASSONNE**

- Enjoy breakfast before departing by coach for Carcassonne.
- Take a guided tour of the outer fortifications of the Cité and des Lices, along with the Château Comtal.
- Savor a special cassoulet lunch at a charming restaurant within the Cité.
- Experience a narrated cruise on the Canal du Midi, setting off from the Port of Carcassonne towards the Mediterranean. This journey includes passing through two locks: the Carcassonne Lock, offering panoramic views of the Medieval City, and exploring the towpath adorned with century-old trees, before navigating through the St. Jean Lock and returning to the Port of Carcassonne.
- Return to the hotel for an overnight stay.



**SEPTEMBER 6:
LA CERDAGNE**

- Enjoy breakfast before departing by coach to explore the beautiful Cerdanya region.
- Begin your journey at the Villefranche-de-Conflent train station, where you will board the yellow train that travels through the stunning Catalan Pyrenees Regional Natural Park, recognized as one of Europe's highest railways.
- After a stop at Mont Louis la Cabanasse, take some free time to explore the Cité de Mont Louis, followed by a delightful lunch at Casot du Cambre in Cabanasse.
- Following lunch, visit the Bains de Saint-Tomas, where you can relax in outdoor pools filled with hot sulfurous water at an altitude of 1,150 meters.
- Wrap up your day with some leisure time for local shopping in Villefranche-de-Conflent before heading back to the hotel for an overnight stay.



**SEPTEMBER 7:
CHÂTEAUX
CATHARES**

- Begin your day with breakfast followed by a coach departure to Cucugnan.
- Experience a guided tour of the Château de Queribus, a remarkably preserved fortress located at over 700 meters high, renowned for its breathtaking views and historical significance as the last bastion of Cathar resistance.
- After savoring a traditional Catalan lunch at Domaine de Rombeau, visit a 16th-century fortress located near the Salses ponds.
- Prior to returning to the hotel, take some time to explore the coastal resort of Barcares and discover the historic ocean liner, Lidia, which was built in 1930.
- Enjoy some free time before settling in for your overnight stay at the hotel.



**SEPTEMBER 8:
FIGUERES AND
BARCELONA**

- Depart from Perpignan early in the morning for an unforgettable day immersed in the world of Salvador Dalí.
- Arrive in Figueres and explore the Dalí Theatre-Museum, a masterpiece designed by the artist himself. With audio guides, you can wander freely while discovering Dalí's most iconic works and his surreal universe.
- Proceed to Cadaqués, one of the most charming villages on the Costa Brava, where Dalí spent much of his life.
- Enjoy a leisurely lunch by the sea and take some time to wander through its narrow, whitewashed streets.
- In the afternoon, travel to Púbol to visit the Gala Dalí Castle, a romantic gift from Dalí to his muse, Gala.
- After your visit, continue on to Playa de Aro on the Costa Brava.
- Dinner and an overnight stay at the "Cap Roig," a 4-star hotel with stunning ocean views.



**SEPTEMBER 9:
END OF THE TRIP**

Breakfast followed by a transfer to Barcelona Airport.

End of the journey.



Price: The cost is \$1,925 per person.
A minimum of 25 guests is required.

There are three types of rooms available:

1. Double Bedroom (one large bed) – **shared.**
2. Twin Room (two single beds) – **shared.**
3. Single Room Option – for one person only.
 - This option requires an additional \$700.
 - Only three single rooms are available in this hotel.

- Accommodation: B&B (bed and breakfast), city tax included, for 7 nights in a double or twin room in Perpignan, 1 night in the Costa Brava.
- 6 Lunches with drinks included (one glass of wine, water, coffee, or tea)
- All visits and entrance fees mentioned in the program guide for 7 days.
- There will be free time in the afternoons.

Price does not include:
